Be Bear Wise!

Bears are beginning to wake from hibernation and will be looking for food sources, including garbage and bird feed. We would like to remind residents that the Feeding of Wildlife By-Law states that no person shall feed or make available food attractants or other substances for the consumption of wildlife. In order to minimize wildlife encounters residents must ensure all attractants such as food products/scraps, garbage, pet food and bird seed is properly stored and all waste is to be placed at the curb in the morning of pickup (not the night before).

The Municipality is responsible for enforcing all Municipal By-Laws. The MNR and the Red Lake OPP work collectively with our By-Law Enforcement Officer to ensure the safety of our residents as it relates to wildlife encounters, including bear encounters.

For emergency situations - if the bear poses immediate threat to public safety by exhibiting threatening or aggressive behaviour, call 911.

For non-emergency encounters or information and advice on reducing bear attractants call the Bear Wise reporting line at 1-866-514-2327. You will be connected to an operator during bear season (April 1st to November 30th). Visit www.ontario.ca/bearwise for more information.
