Notice of New Community Safety Zones

Be advised that the updated Speed and Street Signs By-Law has been passed by Council at the Regular Meeting held on May 21st, 2024 to establish Community Safety Zones. These Safety Zones are located along the roads in front of St. John School / Ecole Catholique Des Etoiles-Du-Nord, Golden Learning Centre and Red Lake District High School. As Howey Street is owned and maintained by the Ministry of Transportation, we are working with the Province to also implement Community Safety Zones along the road in front of Red Lake Madsen Public School and in front of the High School field along Highway 105.

These zones are intended to enhance safety within the area of local schools. If caught speeding in these zones, speed fines will be doubled. We ask that motorists respect the speed zones in these areas for the safety of pedestrians.

Be Bear Wise!

Bears are beginning to come out of hibernation. We would like to remind residents that the Feeding of Wildlife By-Law states that no person shall feed or make available food attractants or other substances for the consumption of wildlife. In order to minimize wildlife encounters residents must ensure all attractants such as food products/scraps, garbage, pet food and bird seed is properly stored and all waste is to be placed at the curb in the morning of pickup (not the night before).

The Municipality is responsible for enforcing all Municipal By-Laws. The MNRF and the Red Lake OPP work collectively with our By-Law Enforcement Officer to ensure the safety of our residents as it relates to wildlife encounters, including bear encounters.

For emergency situations - if the bear poses immediate threat to public safety by exhibiting threatening or aggressive behaviour, call 911.

For non-emergency encounters or information and advice on reducing bear attractants call the Bear Wise reporting line at 1-866-514-2327. You will be connected to an operator during bear season (April 1st to November 30th). Visit www.ontario.ca/bearwise for more information.


