## Update from Truth & Reconciliation Committee

The Municipality of Red Lake's Truth & Reconciliation Committee was established in June 2021 with a mandate to provide leadership, education and action on Municipal responses to the Truth & Reconciliation Commission of Canada's Calls to Action.

- Land Acknowledgement Statement is read aloud at all Council and Committee meetings and is displayed at all municipal facilities.
- Collaborate with community partners in organizing various community education events.
- Welcome sign in Ojibwe, Oji-Cree and syllabics to be installed at Harry's Corner in Spring 2025.
- Provide input into cultural aspects of Norseman Park upgrades.
- Mandatory reconciliation education for all municipal employees.
- National Day for Truth & Reconciliation (September 30<sup>th</sup>) Annual paid holiday for all municipal employees and all municipal facilities are closed to allow time for individual learning and reflection.
- Survivors' Flag raised at Phillip Thomas Vinet Centennial Park.


