

Coming Soon!! FoodCycler Composters

Council has approved participation in a composting pilot program which will allow the municipality to provide 150 FoodCycler composting machines to residents at a reduced price. This electric composter can reduce food waste up to 90%. It is quiet, uses little energy and fits conveniently on a kitchen countertop.

Curbside Collection Reminders

Did you know?

- All garbage and recycling containers must not be more than one (1) meter from the traveled road or curb to ensure pick up.
- Bag tags are required on curbside garbage.
- Sealed containers are preferred, but if you do not have a sealed container, you must ensure your garbage bags are covered to prevent animals from getting into the bags.
- Bags must not be more that 15 kg to ensure pick up.




