In light of increasing credit card processing fees, once the E-transfers and Pre-Authorized Payments (PAPs) are available as a convenient, cost-free alternative to credit card payments, a 2.75% surcharge on all credit card payments will be implemented.

Are you planning to build?

Depending on the development being considered, approval of a planning application may be required in order to obtain a building permit.

The timeframe required for circulation and review of a planning application can be 2 to 6 months. If you are considering building or have a development project planned, it is recommended that you submit your application early.

Do you need a Building Permit?

To help you decide if you need to obtain a permit you can visit our website at www.redlake.ca where you will find a list of projects requiring a Building Permit. If your project does not appear on the list, please contact RSM Building Consultants at info@rsmbuildingconsultants.com.

If you have determined a building permit is required, you may apply online. To obtain a Building Permit you need to:
