Christmas Tree Curbside Collection

Residents can place their Christmas Trees curbside for collection on **Tuesday**, **January 14**th, **2025**. Trees must be cut in half and placed on the curbside the evening before or the day of collection. The tree must be easily accessible and not have been plowed into the snow bank and must NOT be wrapped in a plastic bag.

Residents can also drop trees off at the Municipal Transfer Station for **FREE** during normal operating hours.



2025 Dog Licenses

Reminder to purchase your annual dog licences before January 31st to avoid a late penalty! The following licences are required to be renewed on an annual basis:

Spayed/neutered dog-\$17.00; Non-spayed/non-neutered dog-\$32.00; Each dog in excess of two-\$100.00

Dog licences can be purchased at the Municipal Office during normal business hours.

Reminder - No Overnight Parking

REMINDER! Parking is not permitted on any street between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 am within the Municipality of Red Lake (Cochenour Townsite is exempt). Violators will be ticketed.
