**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 37-2016  
BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT AND REGULATE  
THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS AND BOWS WITHIN  
CERTAIN AREAS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF RED LAKE**

**WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake passed By-Law No. 37-2016 on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2016; and

**WHEREAS** it is deemed necessary to amend By-Law No. 37-2016;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake hereby **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **THAT** the Set Fines attached to By-Law No. 37-2016 be deleted and replaced with the Set Fines attached hereto as Appendix "A" and forming a part of this by-law.
2. **THAT** By-Law No. 37-2016 is hereby amended.
3. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof.

"Part 1 Provincial Offences Act"

Municipality of Red Lake By-Law No. 37-2016: Discharge of Firearms By-Law

Item	Column 1 (Short Form Wording)	Column 2 (Provision creating or defining offence)	Column 3 (Set fines)
1.	Discharged a firearm (bow) within the Prohibited Discharge Area.	Sec. 3.1	\$350.00
2.	Discharged a firearm (bow) within 400 meters of a public park (private park)(public open space)(building)(structure).	Sec. 3.2(a)	\$350.00
3.	Discharged a firearm (bow) within 8 meters of the paved portion of Highway 618.	Sec. 3.2(b)	\$350.00
4.	Permit a shot (bullet)(pellet)(arrow)(projectile) to stray into a prohibited area.	Sec. 3.3	\$350.00

"NOTE: The general penalty provision for the offences listed above is Section 8 of By-Law No. 37-2016, a certified copy of which has been filed and Section 61 of the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33."
