## Your School Board. Your Say!

Did you know your school support designation determines which trustee election you can participate in for in the next municipal and school board elections?

In Ontario, property owners and tenants can choose which school board they support. This designation also helps determine how you're listed on the Preliminary List of Electors, placing you on the correct voters list for the municipal and school board elections.

MPAC (Municipal Property Assessment Corporation) is legislatively responsible for collecting school support designation data. This information is provided to Elections Ontario to help build and maintain the Preliminary List of Electors.

School support designations should be reviewed and, if needed, updated by June 1, 2026, to be accurately included on the Preliminary List of Electors for the election on October 26, 2026.

## What to Know

### Paper Products



Newspapers, flyers, magazines, notepads, loose paper, file folders, any colour paper, brown paper bags, shredded paper, envelopes (with windows removed), flour bags, spiral cans, cookie dough packages, ice cream containers, pet food bags, food service bags and plates.

### Paper Products

- ✓ Place shredded paper in a tied clear plastic bag.
- ✓ Separate from plastic bags used to cover tiems, remove elastic bands.
- ✓ Remove rope handle from bags.
- ✗ **Do not** include soft or hard covered books/novels.

### Boxboard, Cardboard & Cartons



Pizza boxes, direct mailboxes, moving boxes, shoe boxes, cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg cartons, toilet paper and paper towel rolls, beverage cartons, juice and milk cartons, coffee creamers, sugar cartons, soup and sauce cartons, hot and cold beverage cups.

### Boxboard, Cardboard & Cartons

- ✓ Empty
- ✓ Flatten
- ✓ No larger than 60 x 60 cm.

### Metal, Aluminum & Aerosol Containers



Food cans, metal lids, cookie, coffee and tea tins, beverage cans, aluminum foil (ball up), pie plates, frozen food trays, aerosol containers (without toxic, corrosive or flammable symbol), including food spray, hairspray, air fresheners, shaving cream, deodorant.

### Metal, Aluminum & Aerosol Containers

- ✓ Empty and free from food residue.
- ✓ Ball up aluminum foil.
- ✓ Lids on aerosol containers.

### Plastic & Flexible Plastic



Plastic bottles, jugs, containers and lids, wrappings for food products, drinks, cosmetics, personal hygiene products and household cleaning products, toothpaste and hand cream tubes, deodorant, bags used for bread, newspapers and flyers, Overwrap (paper towel and toilet paper), coffee bags, deli pouches, chip bags, bubble wrap, snack wrappers, cereal bags, plastic gift bags.



### Plastic & Flexible Plastic

- ✓ Empty and free from food residue.

### Glass



Clear and coloured glass, food containers, spice bottles, cosmetic containers, oil and vinegar bottles, non-alcoholic glass beverage containers.

### Glass

- ✓ Empty & free of residue.
- ✓ Lids off.
- ✗ **Do not** include alcoholic glass beverage containers.

### Foam Packaging



Foam packaging such as meat trays, takeout containers, cups and dishes, foam packaging for products.

### Foam Packaging

- ✓ Empty and free from food residue.
- ✓ Remove film wrap and absorbent pads from meat trays.
