OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT & ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT D09-26-04/D14-26-06

- **Location:** The subject lands are adjacent to Highway 125 and have frontage on McNeely Bay of Red Lake and form part of Mining Claims KRL124 and 20842. The lands are legally described as being part of Parts 1 and 2, Plan 23R-15245, Parts 1 and 2 and part of Part 3, Plan 23R 11097, Part 1, Plan 23R-10665 and Parts 1 to 8, Plan 23R-9617.
- **Purpose:** The purpose of the applications is to fulfil conditions of Consent Application D10-24-03 which severed lands for the purpose of facilitating a lot addition of approximately 6.9 ha. The purpose of the applications is to reconcile the official plan designation and zoning applicable to the resultant parcel which is utilized as a marina and a base for float planes.

ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT D14-26-05

- **Location:** 3 Goldshore Road
- **Purpose:** The purpose of the application is to amend the Zoning By-Law in a site-specific manner to provide relief from the front, side and rear yard setback regulations as well as the lot coverage regulation to accommodate the construction of a single detached dwelling.

Notice of Work: Howey Mine – Geotechnical Investigation



Teck Resources Limited will be doing a geotechnical investigation to collect below-surface information to further assess the condition of the closed Howey Mine and support future rehabilitation planning.

Where: Select locations within the fenced area as well as near the Community Centre and Legion in Red Lake. There may be temporary impacts to some public parking areas during this time.

When: Work is expected to begin in mid-September and be completed by mid-November 2026. Work hours will generally be between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.

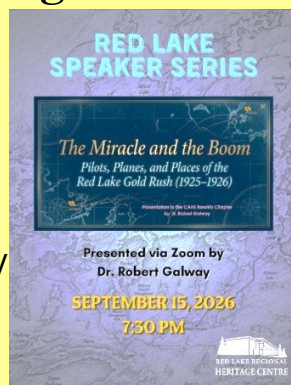
