BY-LAW No. 11-2022

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1930-14
WHICH REGULATES THE USE OF LAND, CHARACTER AND LOCATION OF
BUILDINGS, AND STRUCTURES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF RED LAKE**

WHEREAS the Official Plan of the Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake was approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs on October 22, 2015; and,

WHEREAS the Municipality is in receipt of an application for a zoning by-law amendment and has administered a public meeting in accordance with the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990; and,

WHEREAS Council deems it advisable to amend By-Law No. 1930-14 in accordance within the provisions of Section 34 of the Planning Act, Chapter P13, R.S.O. 1990;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake hereby **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1 – Application

- 1.1 This By-Law shall apply to property located at Mining Claim KRL16898; Mining Claim KFL16899; Mining Claim KRL16901; Mining Claim KRL16902; Part Mining Claim KRL16895; Part 1 23R3623 (Nungesser Road)
- 1.2 A location sketch identified as "Schedule A" is attached hereto and forms part of this By-Law. The property subject to this amendment of the Zoning By-Law is show as "Subject Lands".

SECTION 2 – Purpose and Effect

- 2.1 By-Law No. 1930-14 is hereby amended insofar as it applies to the permitted uses and regulations of lands shown on Schedule A.

Whereas the regulated zoning of the subject lands is Natural Resources (NR), a zone that permits existing shooting ranges, an amendment to change the zoning to site specific Natural Resources (NR-3) would allow for the establishment of a shooting range on the subject property.

SECTION 3 – Amendment

- 3.1 The permitted uses and provisions within the Natural Resources zone being Section 21.4 of the Zoning By-Law are hereby amended by adding the following new section after the sub-section entitled "NR-2 Zone":

NR-3 Zone: Nungesser Road

Notwithstanding any other provision of this By-Law to the contrary, the permitted uses on lands zoned NR-3 shall include a shooting range.

This amendment shall appear as a mapping change to those schedules of the Zoning By-Law that display the subject land being Schedule A1 Townsite of Red Lake.

The land use zoning is therefore changed from Natural Resources (NR) to site specific Natural Resources (NR-3).

SECTION 4 – Conformity

- 4.1 In all other respects the provisions of By-law 1930-14 shall continue to apply.
- 4.2 The proposed By-Law is in conformity with the Official Plan for the Municipality of Red Lake, as provided within the statement given in Schedule B, attached hereto.

THAT By-Law No. 1930-14 is hereby amended.

THAT this By-Law shall come into force and take effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a FIRST and SECOND TIME this 24th day of January, 2022.

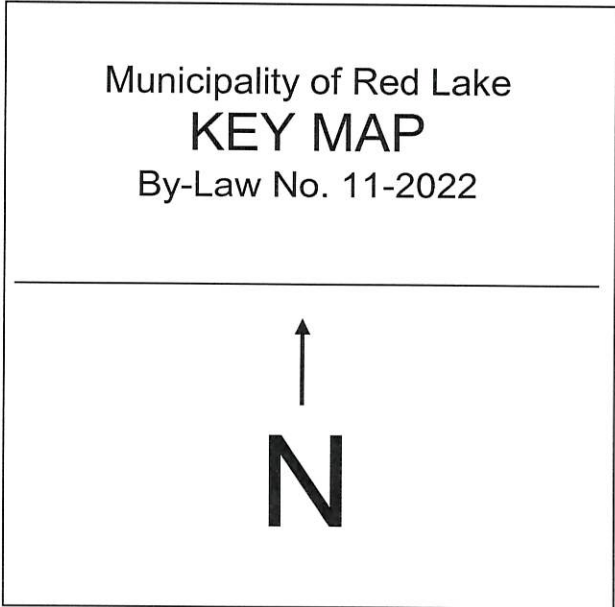
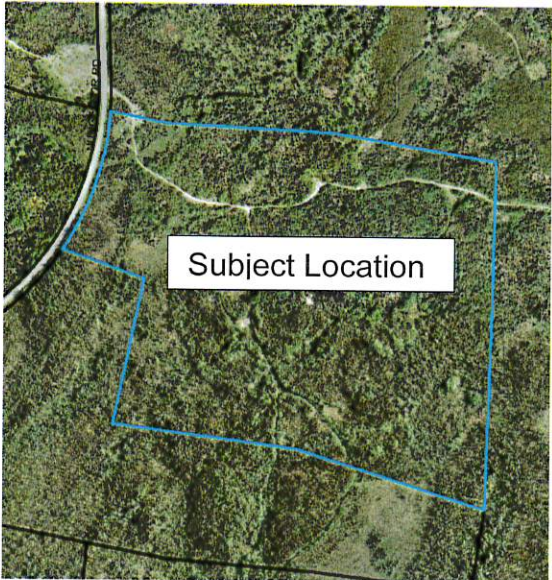
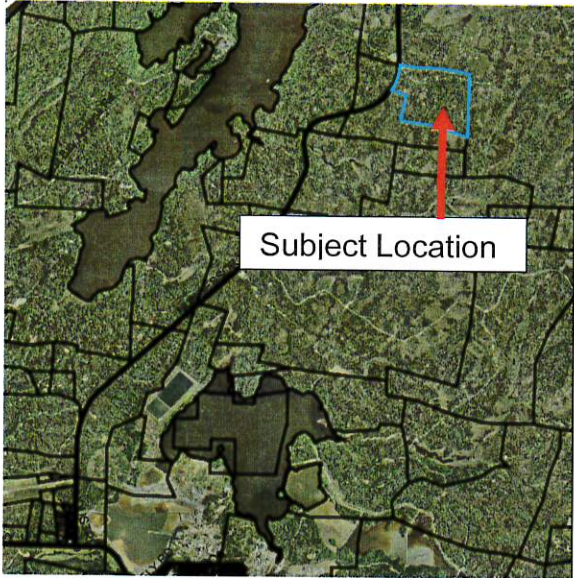
